Do you know what zero is in French?

Children may need help with spellings. Can they create/use a safe phone number and read it in French?

Why is dix an important number when learning to count beyond ten?

Children may need help with spelling; encourage them to pronounce French numbers accurately before spelling.

Children could explore songs and rhymes using online software to help them remember!
