



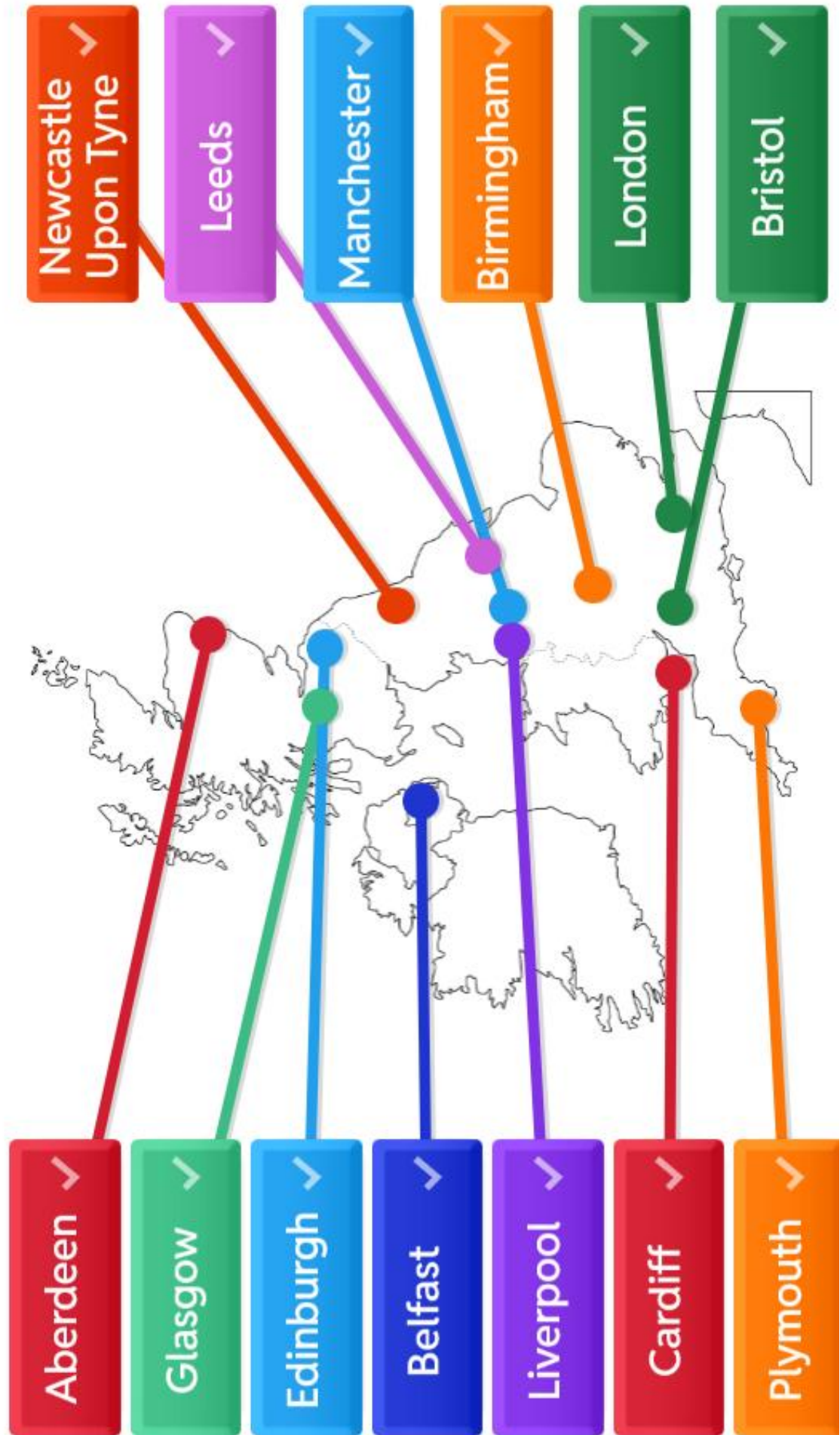

Rung 4

Rung 3

On the blank map of the UK, **point to** Aberdeen, Glasgow, Edinburgh, Belfast, Liverpool, Cardiff, Plymouth, Newcastle, Leeds, Manchester, Birmingham, London, Bristol.

Talk about Edinburgh, Cardiff, London and Belfast being the capitals of the four counties. Look on the internet for familiar landmarks in some of the cities.
