Love of Learning Geography Ladder: Level 1C UK Rivers

Colour in the rungs of the ladder when you think that you can do the challenge without help on **at least three different days. Can your grown up do it too?**

Rung 4

Draw and label the rivers of the UK on the map

Extra challenge. Can you research our local rivers (Blyth and Wansbeck)? Can you draw them on the map? What sea do they flow into? Have you visited these rivers before? Use Google maps to find out more.

When drawing the river, it does not need to be exact. Focus on the location and length. Children may need help with spellings, encourage them to use a capital letter for each of the labels.

Rung 3

Label the rivers of the UK and name the sea the river flows into

Children can draw over the river and follow the journey to help locate the sea the river flows into. Discuss that the mouth of the river is where it flows into the sea and the source of the river is where the river begins.

Rung 2

Label the rivers of the UK using the names at the bottom of the page

Children may need help with reading some of the names of the rivers. Encourage children to use a capital letter for each of the labels. Model learning by completing challenges with the children.

Rung 1

Point to the rivers

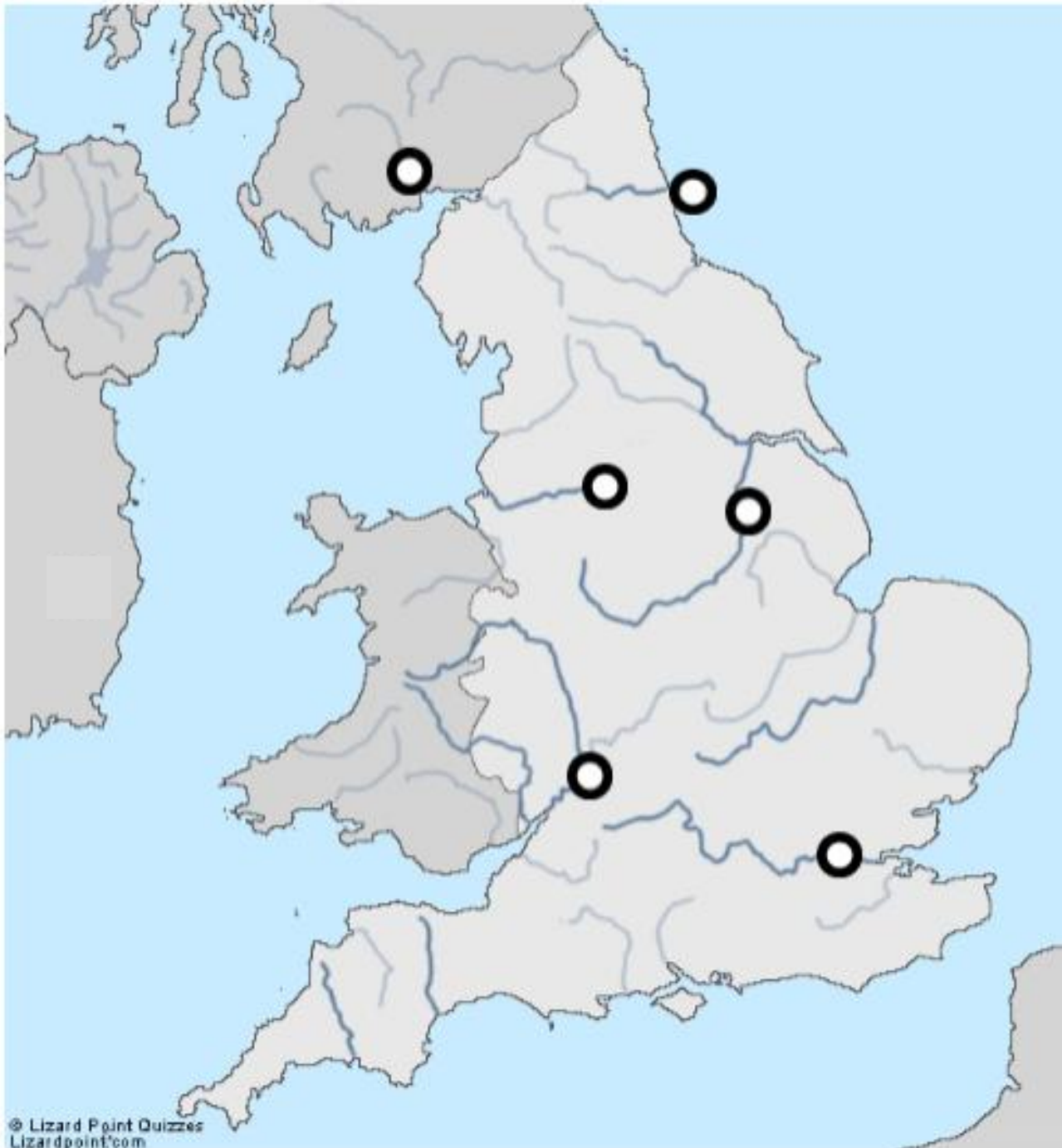
Remember, keep sessions short and fun.

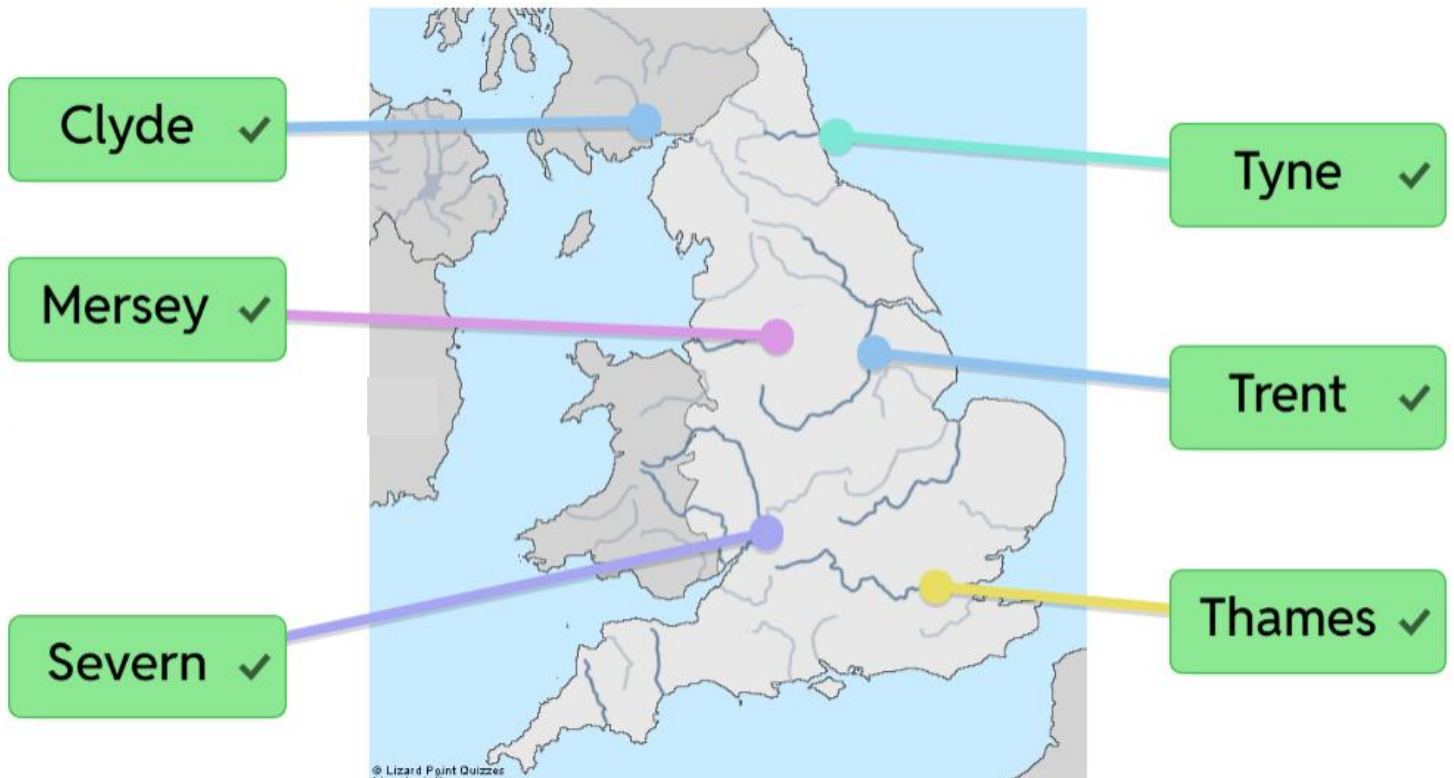
