Rung 3

Point to the tallest mountains of the UK using the name labels. Which country are they located?

Use Google Earth to locate the mountains. How tall are the mountains? Can you order them from smallest to largest?

Encourage children to use a capital letter for each of the labels. Which country is the mountain located in?

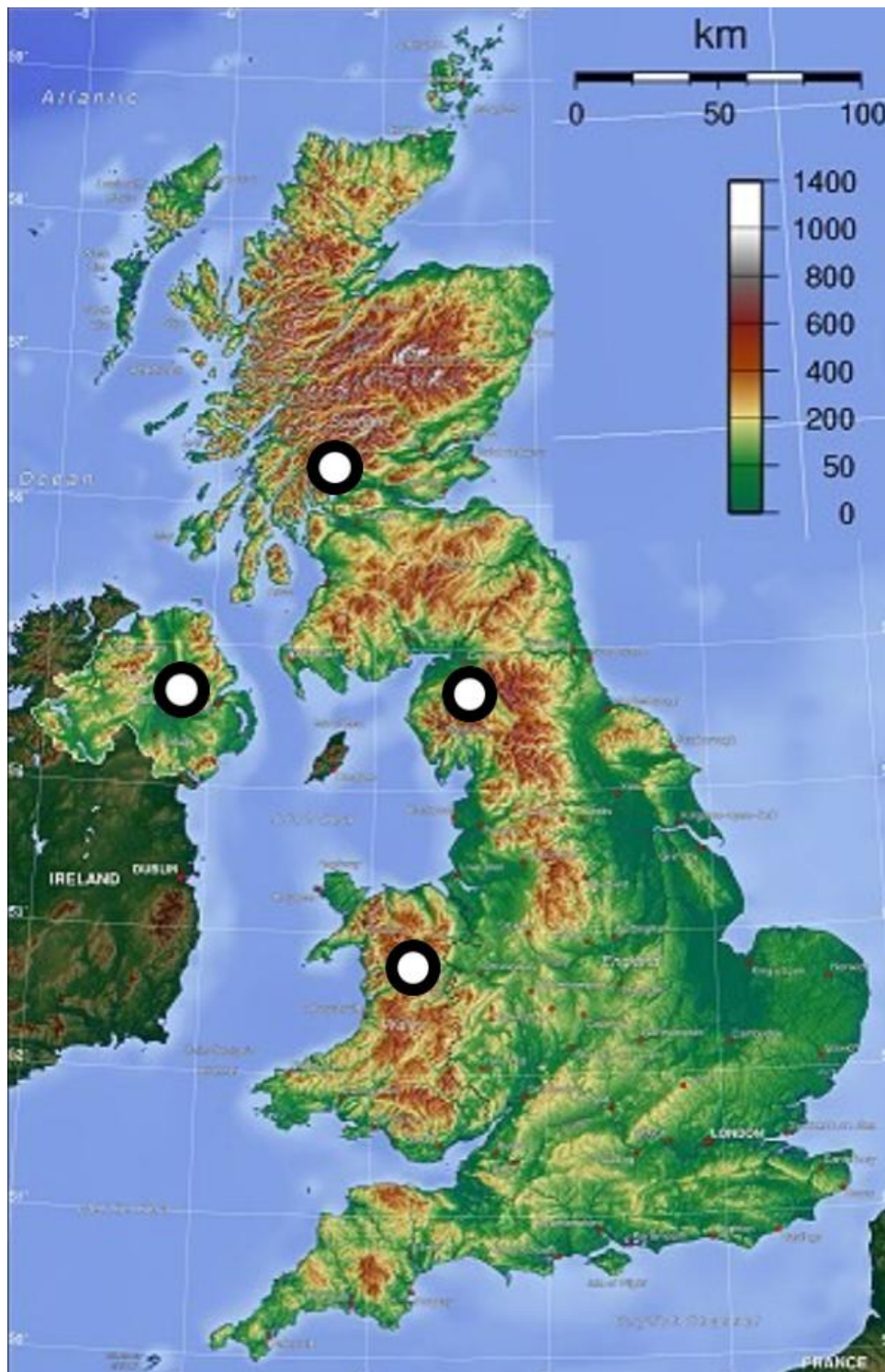

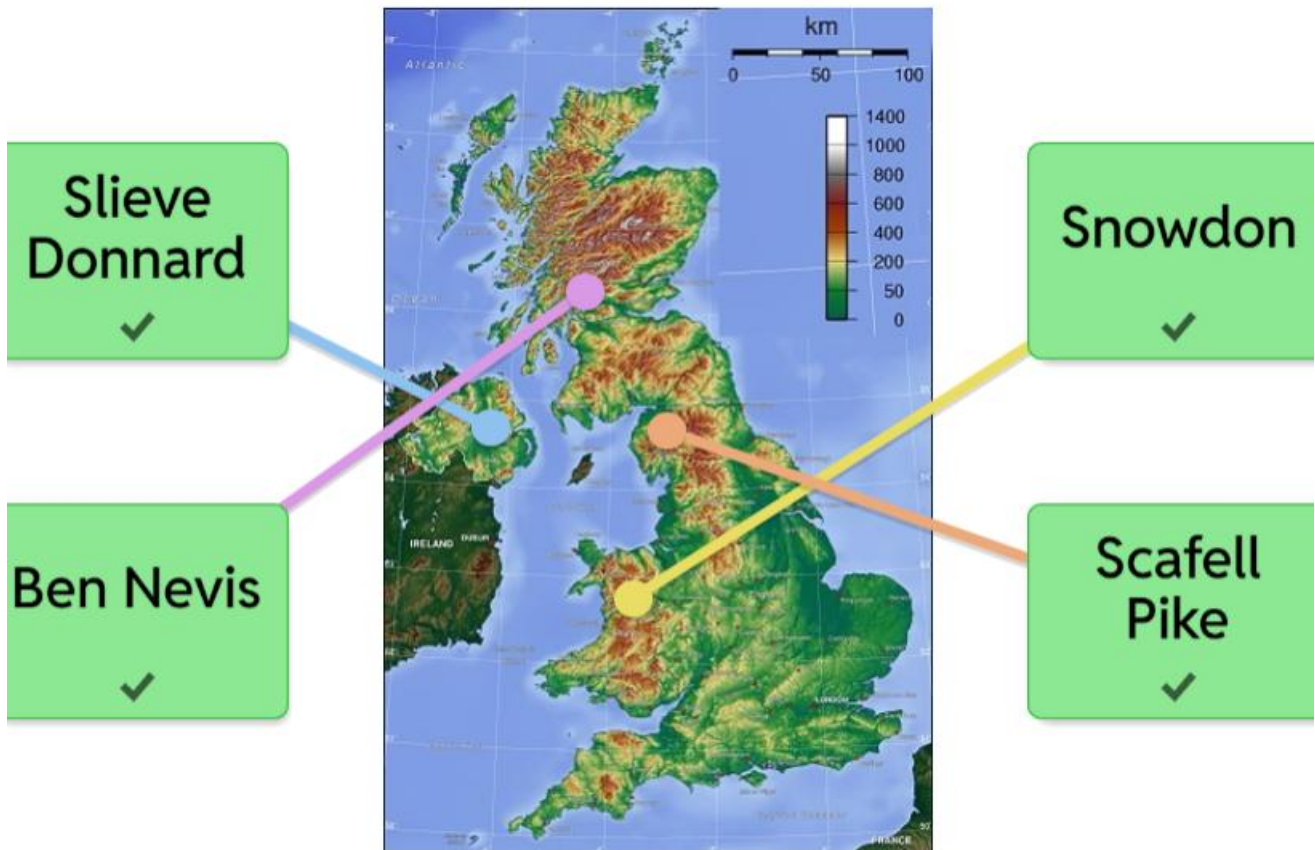
