Extra challenge. What is the country below Northern Ireland? What is the capital of that country? What can you find out about the small islands around the outside of the country?

#### Rung 4

**Label** Edinburgh, Cardiff, London, Belfast, Newcastle and Blyth.

Children may need help with spellings, encourage them to use a capital letter for each of the labels.

#### Rung 3

**Point to** where Edinburgh, Cardiff, London, Belfast, Newcastle and Blyth are.

Talk about Edinburgh, Cardiff, London and Belfast being the capitals of the four counties. Look on the internet for familiar landmarks in each of the capitals.

#### Rung 2

**Label** England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland, North Sea, Atlantic Ocean

Children may need help with spellings, encourage them to use a capital letter for each of the labels.

#### Rung 1

**Point to** England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland, North Sea, Atlantic Ocean

Well done for getting started. Short fun sessions are the best. Talk about things that may give relevance to the chat. 'We went on holiday to Scotland.' 'Great Aunt Ethel lives in Wales'.
